(3) The BEA's personal income per capita includes income from all sources, while the U.S. Census Bureau's income per capita excludes certain sources of income such as interest, dividends, Medicare, payments in kind, etc. (4) The personal wealth indicator is a measure of the percent of income from dividends, interest, and rent compared with the U.S. average. This is one indicator of personal wealth.
